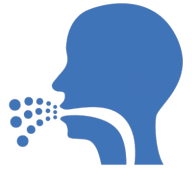

Patient Advisory and Acknowledgement For COVID-19 Safety

Measures to Protect Patients

- All patients coming into the office must wear a **mask**.
- We placed signage at the entrance of our office that we expect patients to maintain a six feet of distance between themselves.
- Plexiglass shields are placed on the counter between patient and front desk staff.
- In addition, to adhering to the strict protocols already established in our practice, all patients are being asked a series of **“screening” questions** when making an appointment and a day prior to their appointment.
- Each patient's **temperature** will be taken upon arrival to the clinic.
- Patients will be asked to use the **hand sanitizer** upon arrival to the clinic.
- Chairs and exam beds are being disinfected in between each patient.
- Doorknobs are being disinfected four times during the day.
- Sinks are always available throughout the clinic for handwashing.
- We have continued to offer telemedicine virtual appointments from the comfort of your own home.

Measures to Prevent Crowds From Gathering

- We limited the number of patients in the clinic at any given time and appointments are required (including allergy injections).
- The seating arrangement in the reception area has been clearly marked to ensure social distancing with a 6 feet distance.
- No accompanying guests for our patients appointments. Patients less than 18 years of age may bring 1 parent/legal guardian to their appointment
- We removed certain items in our waiting room such as magazines, questionnaires and pamphlets.
